Dear Parents,

I am writing to request **100 Euros** per child for the Anglophone Section Funds, academic year 2023/24.

Your 100 Euros contribution covers the section fund (85 Euros) and the class fund (15 Euros). We ask parents to make a single transfer as opposed to many small requests throughout the academic year.

Those who decide not to contribute to the fund will be billed accordingly throughout the year.

At the end of a school year, any class fund which has not been spent, moves up with your child to their new teacher. At the end of P5, any left-over class fund is refunded back to parents.

How your contribution is used

Section Fund

This fund is for the whole section. Examples of what the fund supports include: the purchase of schemes of work; stationary and supplies; section events; performances and outings; assessment materials; teaching equipment and software/apps.

A few examples of how the fund was used this year include: a Christmas theatre trip, a visit from a theatre company, sports day equipment, prizes for the Story Slam and the summer reading challenge, purchase of subscriptions such Times Table Rockstars, etc.

Class Fund

This fund is used by class teachers to buy small, disposable items such as craft materials, rewards, seasonal activities, celebrations, pens, pencils, art supplies, etc.

Additional Payments

We have much hope that your 100EUR, will cover all activities for the next school year. However, there are sometimes school events and projects that we were unable to plan for in advance. In these circumstances, we may ask parents of the affected class(es) for an additional contribution.
