### **Purposes and legal basis of data processing**

The legal basis for data processing is § 4 para. 1 BDSG n.F. and Art. 6 para. 1f GDPR.

Video surveillance serves the following purposes:

- Protection and surveillance of the school perimeter, school grounds and school buildings
- Protection from violence against pupils, visitors and staff
- Improve law enforcement by preserving evidence in cases of vandalism, damage to property, theft and other criminal offences
- Enforcement of claims for damages

### **Legitimate interests pursued**

- Protection of the school perimeter
- Protection of the school grounds and buildings
- Protection of life, health and property
- Exercise of domiciliary rights
- Improving prevention and law enforcement

### **Duration of storage or criteria for determining the duration**

The video images of the data subject are deleted or blocked as soon as the purpose of storage no longer applies. The storage period is usually 14 days.

If a criminal offence is suspected, the retention period increases in accordance with the statute of limitations.

## **Recipients or categories of recipients of the data (if data transfer takes place)**

In order to fulfil the above purposes, it may be necessary for the ESM to transmit video images to the following entities:

- Authorised employees
- Authorities entitled to information
- IT service provider

## **Information on the rights of the data subjects**

If you have any questions or complaints about data protection, please feel free to contact us. ## **Right of objection according to Art. 21 GDPR**
