Dear Parents,

I am writing to request a contribution of **70 Euros** per child for the academic year 2021/22.

Your 70 Euros contribution covers the section fund (60 Euros) and the class fund (10 Euros). We ask parents to make a single contribution as opposed to many small requests throughout the academic year.

Those who decide not to contribute to the fund will be billed accordingly throughout the year.

Any class fund which has not been spent moves up with your child to their new teacher. At the end of P5, any left over fund is refunded back to parents.

The class fund portion has been reduced this year as most classes still have some funds left over due to the restrictions on trips and activities caused by covid and distance learning.

How your contribution is used

Section Fund

This fund is for the whole section. Examples of what the fund supports include: the purchase of schemes of work; stationary and supplies; section events; performances and outings; assessment materials; teaching equipment and software/apps.

Class Fund

This fund is used by class teachers to buy small disposable items such as craft materials, rewards, seasonal activities, celebrations, pens, pencils, art supplies, etc.
